

Unaccompanied Minors Policy

All unaccompanied minors are accepted for carriage under the guidelines of this policy. All unaccompanied minors must either present a fully completed unaccompanied minors form at time of travel or have a valid form on file at 360 Discovery (in the specific case of regular travelers).

For travel on any of 360 Discovery's vessels, a minor is considered to be a child between the ages of six and 14 years of age inclusive. A minor is considered to be unaccompanied if they intend to travel without a parent, guardian or caregiver over the age of 18 years. No child aged less than six years of age may travel alone on a 360 Discovery vessel.

From time to time 360 Discovery vessels are required to make both scheduled and unscheduled stops en route to final destinations, neither the master, crew or 360 Discovery as an entity will accept responsibility during these stops for the minor. (Except in an emergency situation where the minor will be assisted along with other passengers in accordance with standard 360 Discovery safety procedures.)

Bookings for unaccompanied minors cannot be confirmed until a fully completed unaccompanied minor form has been sighted by 360 Discovery staff. Regular travelers such as school students will be accepted for travel without a fully completed unaccompanied minor form provided a valid form is held on file at 360 Discovery.
